April 1, 2015 to March 31, 2019

The Alberta Bio Future program is the province's flagship initiative to advance the bioeconomy. Launched in 2014-15, this program offers funding and connections to develop sustainable and profitable products and technologies from Alberta biomass in the areas of advanced biomaterials, biochemicals and bioenergy. The program is administered by Alberta Innovates' Bioindustrial Innovation Team and is cofunded by Alberta Innovates and Alberta Economic Development Trade and Tourism.

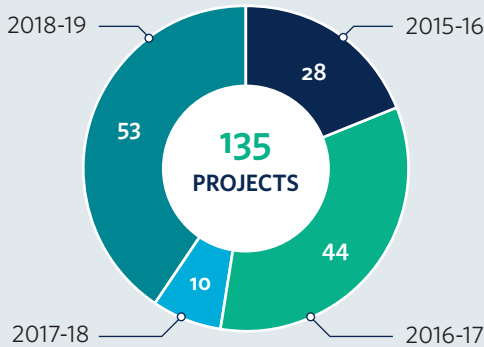

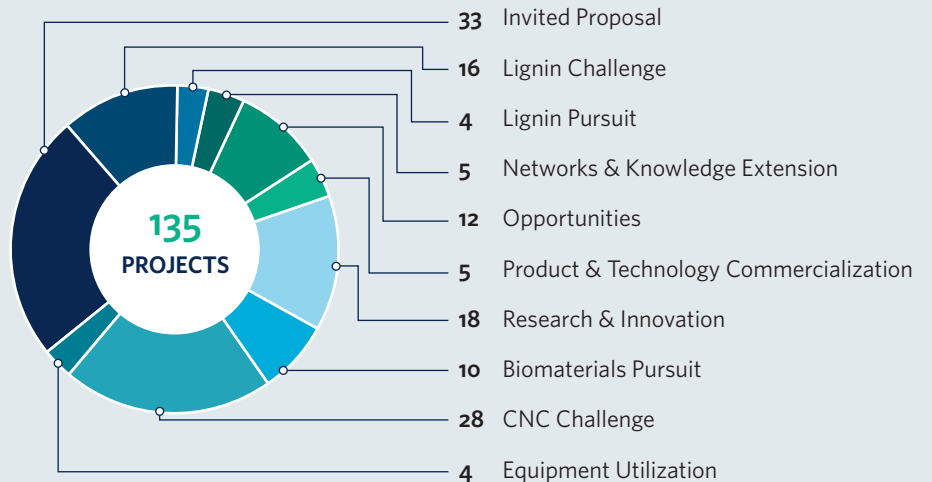

(by year the project started)



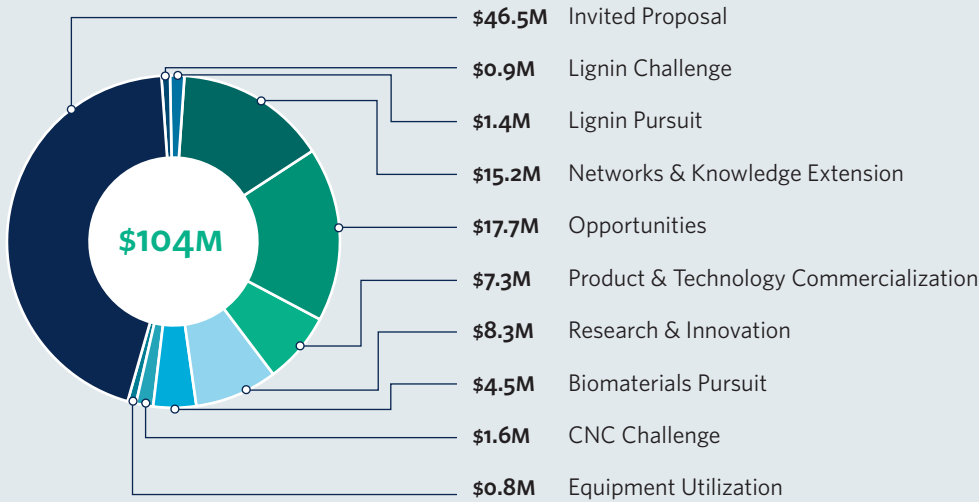
PROJECTS

(by subprogram)

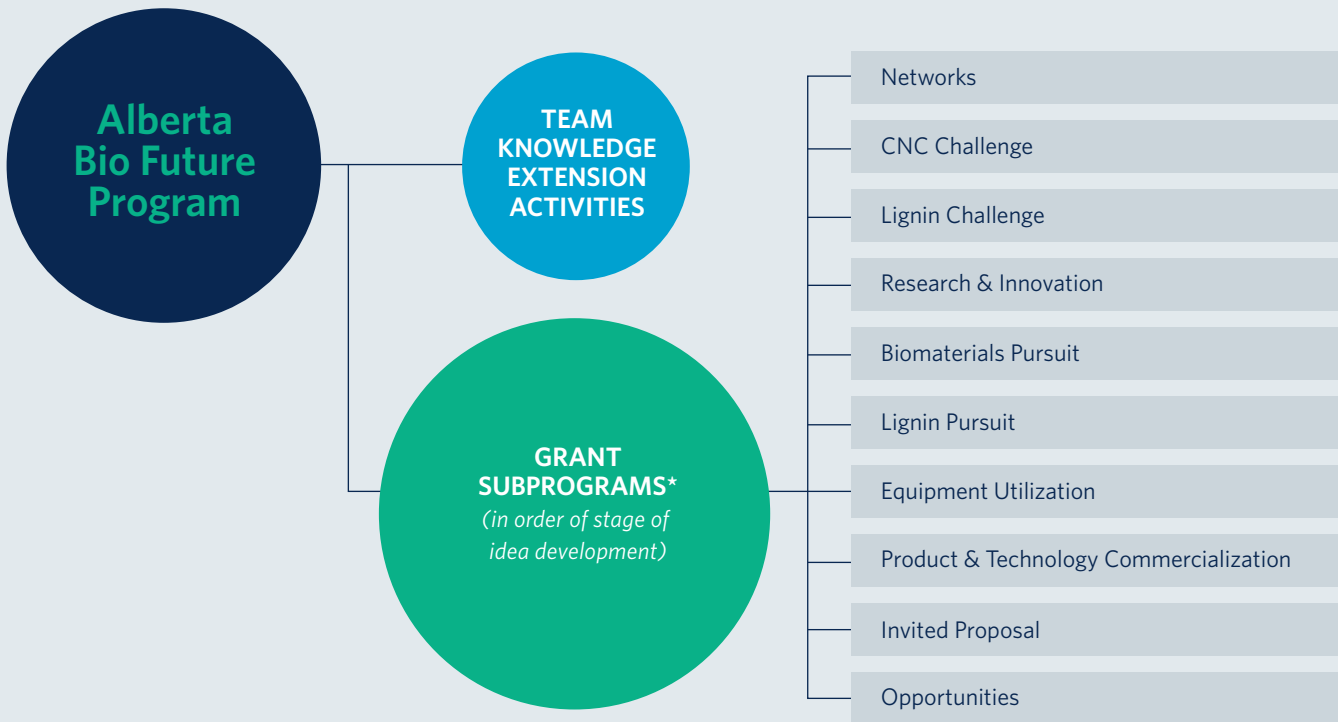


PROJECTS
